

Types of patent





 In conformity with CPTPP requirement, novety grace period has been expanded from 6 months to 12 months





Document requirements



- All documents of the application have to be made in Vietnamese.
 - Power of attorney, documents certifying the right of registration, documents evidencing the grounds for priority claiming may be made in other languages but must be translated into Vietnamese.
 - Copies of the priority applications must be translated into Vietnamese on the request of the Office.
- POA can be submitted
 - Within 1 month from filing date for Conventional filing
 - Within 34 months from priority date for PCT filing
- Not require to submit the copy of the priority application in case of PCT

Unpatentable subject mattes



IP Law, Article 59: Excluded subject matters

- 1. Scientific discoveries or theories, mathematical methods;
- 2. Schemes, plans, rules and methods for performing mental acts, training domestic animals, playing games, doing business; computer programs;
- 3. Presentations of information;
- 4. Solutions of aesthetical characteristics only;
- 5. Plant varieties, animal breeds;
- 6. Processes of plant or animal production which are principally of biological nature other than microbiological ones;
- 7. Human and animal disease prevention, diagnostic and treatment methods.

IP Law, Article 8:

... not protect intellectual property objects which are contrary to national laws, social morality and public order or harmful to national defence and security.

Special practices



Use claim is not allowed

not interpreted as product or process.

Software related invention

 Article 5.8.2.5 Patent examination guideline: Computer software implemented invention is not excluded from patentability if it has a technical character.

The interpretation of technical character is that the computer program, when carried out has to provide a "further technical effect". The normal technical effects like flow of electrical current are not sufficient.

Accelerated examination



 ASPEC with ASEAN patent offices, conventional PPH with JPO (200 cases/year) and KIPO (100 cases/year)

Requirements:

- A "Request for Substantive Examination" must have been filed either at the time of the PPH request or previously
- No substantial office action has been issued
- Copies of all office actions which were issued for the corresponding application and copies of all claims determined to be patentable/allowable
- All claims on file, as originally filed or as amended must sufficiently correspond to one or more claims indicated as allowable in the corresponding application
- Claim correspondence table
- First office action in 9 months
